*Your Money New York* is an easy-to-use Web site that connects New Yorkers with information and assistance from New York State and local governments as well as the federal government to give them the necessary tools to build a strong financial future. With links to money-related matters, *Your Money New York* addresses topics such as credit cards, debt, banking, home ownership, and college and retirement savings, and offers special sections for families, college students, senior citizens, members of the military, and Spanish-speaking individuals.

## **Why was *Your Money New York* created?**

These are difficult economic times and more families are struggling to make ends meet. *Your Money New York* is a financial education initiative developed to help New Yorkers deal with the broad variety of money-related issues they may be facing—whether it's getting out of debt, looking for a job, saving for college or retirement, or buying a car or home.
